- A. The contractor shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid. Deputy Commissioner of Income tax (HQ)(Admn) O/o Pr. Chief Commissioner of Income-tax Karnataka and Goa Region, Bengaluru, will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
- B. The Contractor shall quote the rates for the proposed work in the prescribed proforma
- C. The contractor should submit the Technical and Financial Bid separately.

The financial bid should be placed in sealed cover.

- **D.** The rate quoted should be **inclusive of all taxes**, including labour and other miscellaneous costs etc.
- E. Besides the buyback amount should be deducted from the total bid amount before taxes. - J. The contractee's decision with regard to the quality of the material and workmanship will be final and binding. Any material rejected by the contractee shall be immediately removed by the contractor and replaced by material of acceptable and specified quality and standards material as prescribed in National Building code and as per guidelines prescribed by the Directorate of Estates.. Technical requirements are subjected to enhancement/modification and the bidder will be bound to adhere to such conditions.
- K. The work shall comply with the specifications, using the standard material as prescribed in National Building code and as per guidelines prescribed by the Central Public Works Department, Government of India.
- L. The Materials, workmanship, fabrication and construction shall be of the specified and agreed quality and all materials shall be new and material as prescribed in National Building code and as per guidelines prescribed by the Central Public Works Department.
- M. Where, during such guarantee periods as mentioned above, any material or equipment or workmanship or generally any item of work fails to comply or is not in conformity with the requirements stipulated in the Contract Documents or not in accordance with the criteria and provisions of the guarantee, the contractor shall be responsible for and shall bear and pay all costs and expenses for replacing and/or rectifying and making good such materials, equipment, workmanship, and items of work.
